CASE 1: Mistakes Cannot Be Undone But Mishaps Can Be !!!

A 42-year-old male patient reported to the Postgraduate Clinic of Department of Conservative Dentistry and Endodontics, Thai Moogambigai Dental College and Hospital for restoration of maxillary left first premolar (24). The medical history of the patient was non - relevant. He had a past dental history of endodontic treatment done by a general dentist before 3 months. On clinical examination, the tooth was asymptomatic to palpation and percussion tests. There was no mobility and no periodontal attachment loss .Disloged composite core was present in 24 exposing two metal posts one in the buccal and one in the palatal aspect of the remaining tooth structure.

Radiographic evaluation revealed two active threaded metallic posts that had been improperly placed in the root dentin palatal to the root canals with no periodontal changes. On the basis of clinical and radiographic examination, we planned to do non surgical retreatment for 24 followed by prefabricated post and core and crown.





During the first visit, local anaesthesia was administered followed by placement of rubber dam. Composite core was removed using a high speed hand-piece to expose the posts. The posts were retrieved using an ultrasonic device with a non- coated ultrasonic tip. Post space on the palatal aspect showed no signs of perforation and was restored using type II GIC and a temporary restoration was given using Cavit G.





During the second visit, retrieval of gutta-percha was done from the root a canal, Ledge in the buccal root canal in the middle third was by passed, patency achieved and working length was determined. Canals were shaped to 30 .06 using NiTi rotary endodontic files and calcium hydroxide medicament placed in the canals for a week. On the third visit, after a period of 2 weeks, the canals were obturated with 0.02 guttapercha cones and AH plus sealer using lateral compaction technique









On the next visit postspace was prepared in the palatal canal and a prefabricated tapered passive fiber reinforced composite post luted using self-etch dual-cure resin cement followed by a composite core. Patient was referred to Department of Prosthodontics for fabrication of fixed partial denture in relation to 24 and 27 .Patient was recalled for follow up after a month and the outcome of the treatment was quite satisfactory.






CASE 2: Can a tooth with Internal Resorption be saved ???

A 35-year-old male adult reported to the Postgraduate Clinic of Department of Conservative Dentistry and Endodontics, Thai Moogambigai Dental College and Hospital with a chief complaint of dull pain in mandibular left first molar 36. The medical history of the patient was non-contributory. Past dental history revealed that root canal treatment was initiated a year back. On clinical examination, Previously endodontic therapy had been initiated in 36. The tooth was symptomatic to palpation and percussion tests and there was no signs of periodontal attachment loss.

Radiographic evaluation showed radiolucency in middle third of mesiobuccal root surface of the molar indicating internal resorption and an associated radiolucency in the periapical area of same tooth. On the basis of clinical and radiographic examination a diagnosis and treatment plan were formulated.

On the day of visit, local anaesthesia was administered followed by placement of rubber dam. The temporary restoration was removed and the access was refined. Patency was achieved using a 10 size K file and working length was established. Canals were enlarged upto 30 .06 using niti rotary endodontic files and calcium hydroxide dressing was placed in the canals for a week





After 7 days, obturation of the canals were done with 0.02 guttapercha cones and AH plus sealer using lateral compaction technique. A hot plugger of the desired size was introduced, shearing the points off approximately 4 to 5 mm from the apex. Vertical compaction was done using hand plugger to the apical plug of gutta-percha to fill the internal resorptive defect. The remaining canal was then back filled using thermoplasticized gutta-percha technique. The patient was recalled after 6 months. The follow-up radiograph showed peri-apical healing of 36.





CASE 3: Crown Lengthening Using Apically Repositioned Flap

A 35 year old Female visited the Department of Periodontics, with an intention of replacing her missing teeth. On examination, it was seen that the clinical crown in relation to 13 and 14 was short and needed crown lengthening. The biologic width was compromised but the width of the attached gingiva was adequate and so, an apically repositioned flap was planned and performed in relation to 13,14 and the bone contour was corrected in 14 and The flap was apically repositioned and sutured.







A Satisfactory healing was seen after a week and the sutures were removed and crown preparation was modified and final adjustments were done in the metal trial. The final prosthesis was delivered after a week. Restoring her back with a healthy smile.





CASE 4: A Minimally Invasive Approach To Treat Gummy Smile: Laser-assisted Lip Repositioning Surgery


A 19years old Female came with the complaint of incompetent lips with gummy smile to Department of Periodontics & Implantology, Thai Moogambigai Dental College & Hospital. Diode laser with the 830 nm in 1.8 W was used in continuous brush stroke. After thorough oral prophylaxis, local Anesthesia was given (infiltration). FIRST INCISION- At the level of MGJ followed by SECOND INCISION- 16mm from the first incision.



Myotomy performed, fibres were relieved to reduce the hyperactivity of upper lip. Sutures were placed, Post operative instructions given, Medications prescribed. Healing & Competency Of Lips At Followup—15 Days, 3 months, 6 months.









✓ CULTURAL EVENTS:
